

CHANGES TO NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH AND FARM WATCH.

The Neighbourhood watch and farm watch system has now been changed. In the past messages sent by the Police used to be distributed by the Voice Connect system to area co-ordinators, who then forwarded the information to their members within each scheme either through phone calls or emails. This voice connect system has become outdated and so has been replaced by a new system.

The system which is now being used allows all members and co-ordinators to register and receive the messages directly. The new system is called Cumbria Community Messaging and you can register to the appropriate watch by visiting the following website www.cumbriacommunitymessaging.co.uk. Once on the website just follow the registration instructions. When registering you can choose how you would like to receive the messages either via email, text or land line.

If you do not have access to the internet you can still be part of neighbourhood and/or farm watch please contact either myself PCSO 5206 Dakin or PCSO 5245 Thomas and we can complete a registration form for you to sign, then you can choose to receive the messages either by land line or mobile phone.
